Requirement to register courses for all students

Item 8(1) of Postgraduate Academic Guidelines states that:

- a) A student must register his/her courses every semester within the specified dates determined by the University. Those who fail to register without acceptable reasons will be terminated.
- b) Students who do not register for any courses must apply for the deferment of the study and the deferment is considered as a period of study (refer to Item 21: Deferment, Suspension and Termination).

Other important Notes:

- Students are compulsory to register the research course code for each semester except after thesis submission.
- Students are compulsory to passed Research Methodology Course before doing their First Assessment.
- All Master by Research programmes have at least one university compulsory course with course U###. Please refer to School's Registration Kit website for further details of the course.

Definition of label in the course code

- The '#' item in the course code M### refers to programme code.
- For example, the programme code for Master of Philosophy in Chemical engineering is **MKKK**, then the course codes for this programme are MKKK 1100, MKKK 1200, MKKK 2100, MK2200, etc.
- For course code M### 1200

1 is the year and **2** is the semester of the academic session.
